Minor Requirements

Minors involve substantial work in a discipline, but offer less depth and integration than a major. More than half of the courses in a minor must be successfully completed at Wofford. In addition, a student must earn a grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 in the courses that fulfill requirements for the minor.
